The neighbourhood profiles provide demographic and household information from the Census. The data was obtained from Statistics Canada through the community data program and compiled by the City of Regina.











# Highest Certificate, Diploma Or Degree For The Population Aged 15 Years And Over In Private Households




# Population Aged 15 Years And Over By Labour Force Status








### Household Total Income Groups In 2020 For Private Households (Pre & Post Tax)





Population, By Age Group, With After Tax Income Below The Low Income Measure










# Population By Immigration Catagory

# Immigrant Population By Year Of Immigration








